

Florence Le Claire and Roy Dupre Inter Club Weekend Triples competition

1. Each club to select 4 Ladies to represent them in The Florence Le Claire Competition, and 4 Men to represent them in the Roy Dupre weekend tournament
2. Bowls Jersey selectors can select players from all clubs to represent them, but only once they have asked permission from the clubs that they do not need that player to represent their club
3. Each Team plays other once, with a player dropping out at least once during the weekend
4. All players are expected to be present for all games , as they are there to be used as a substitute if any of the players named to play in a session is injured or taken ill
5. No other players can be called in to the team, only the Four names submitted to the official running the competition can play over the weekend.
6. Each player has Three bowls and the game is played over 18 Ends
7. If an end is burnt the jack is placed on the "T"
8. The winning team receives 2 points, and drawn game receives 1 Point
9. When the tournament is completed it is the team with the most points that is the winner. If the Points are equal, it is then on shot difference. If that is equal, it is on most shots scored, if that is equal it is who won the game between the two teams in contention
10. Club colours are to be worn, and Bowls Jersey team wears the Bowls Jersey kit
11. The Family are asked to present the trophy
